When?

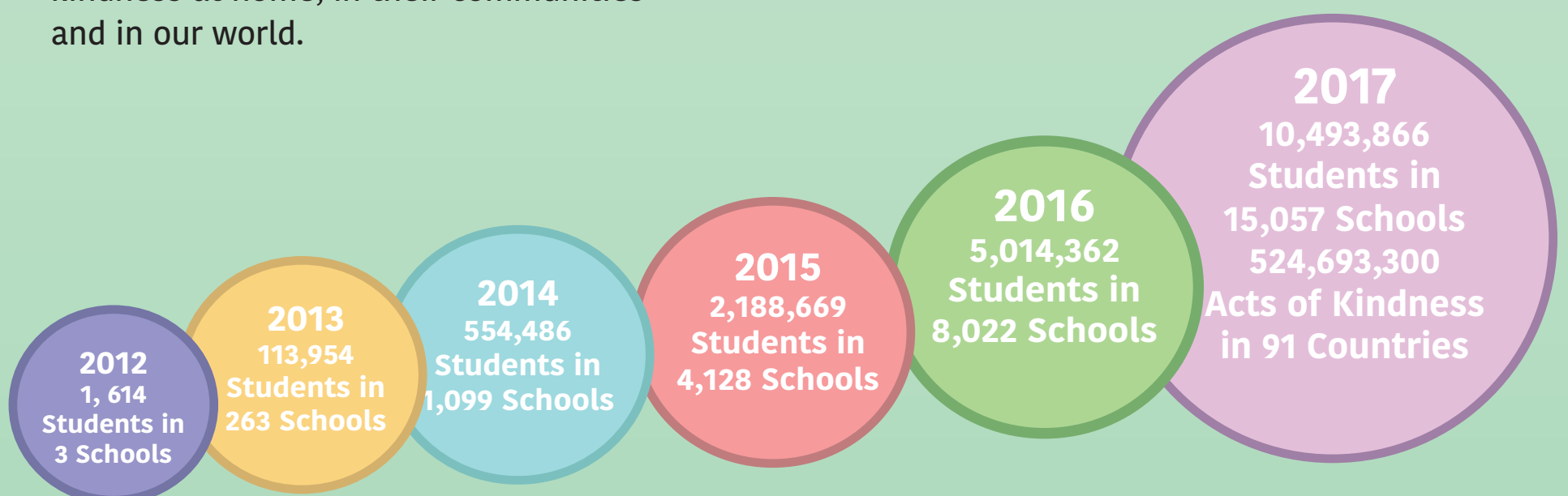
